RULES FOR LIBRARY: (GYAN PARAB)

- > Students need to bring I-card in library and register their name in register book compulsory.
- > Silence must be maintained in the library.
- > One library card to each student by which she can avail a book for 14 days. Thereafter penalty of Rs. 1 per day will be charged.
- > Reference books and magazines will have to be used in the library only.
- > Everyone should issue a book on their own library card.
- ➤ Before issuing the book, Students are advised to check the condition of book, if they find book in a damaged condition than they need to inform the librarian immediately.
- > If the library card is lost, students have to inform the librarian immediately.
- > Deposit for membership for the library is Rs.100 for a year.
- > Overnight lending book issue will be on I-card of students only. This is only for one night.
- > The rules are binding on all who use the library.
