Overview of our college

With the motto of women empowerment and providing quality education, Shree Meghmani Parivar and Shree Bhailalbai A. Patel (Detrojwala) Umiya Arts and Commerce College for Girls has been expanding its horizons, spreading its wings and embracing new opportunities. Our college is celebrating its 25th year of successful accomplishment this year.

Shri Umiya K.V.C. Education Trust established Shree Meghmani Parivar and Shree Bhailalbai A. Patel (Detrojwala) Umiya Arts and Commerce College for Girls in Ahmedabad in 1998 – with the mission to empower girls of rural and semi-urban areas, who are deprived of opportunity for higher education.

Our college emphasizes on holistic learning through community based activities and is not mere a platform for academic achievements. It is a perfect blend of traditional Indian values and modern advancements. The campus is always full of life with numerous co-curricular and extracurricular activities. The students are properly guided and channelized into the main stream with tireless efforts of our faculty members. The institute is an endeavour to provide exposure to the students who are highly ambitious and focused. Along with academics, the students are free to choose any activities among sports, cultural pursuits, NCC or NSS to follow their passion giving chances to recognize their potential.

The institution is thoroughly dedicated to convert its goal into reality. The innovations and quality improvements are stimulated. Learning is made more student-centric by stressing proficiency in English, vocational skills, personality development, career guidance, placement training, social welfare, and community engagements with the use of contemporary teaching and learning methods.

1. New Events:

The year 2025-26 saw following new activities undertaken by our college.

- The college hosted Gujarat University Ellis-bridge North Zone Inter-Collegiate Youth Festival on 09th and 10th September 2026. The college, as the host, welcomed more than a thousand students from more than 50 colleges affiliated to Gujarat university, participating in 29 events. The students of our college stood victorious in 11 events - Poster Making, Clay Modelling, On the Spot Painting, Folk Dance, Elocution, Mimicry, Debate, Collage, Folk Orchestra, Mehndi and Installation. Advancing further, the college secured 3 prizes at events like Folk Orchestra, Mehndi and Mimicry at Inter-Zonal Youth Festival as well. The proud team of Folk Orchestra marched further and represented Gujarat University at Inter-University Youth Festival as well.
- The college hosted One Day National Seminar on “GST Reforms, Digitalization, Compliance & Ease of Doing Business” in collaboration with ICSSR on 14th March, 2026. 168 participants comprising of academicians, research scholars and students were benefitted by the experts.
- On 17th March, 2026. One day Personality Development Programme was held at the college by Disha Bharat Gujarat. Around 125 girls students actively participated in the program. Students underwent various interesting sessions during the course of the program.
- Civil Defence Training, especially Fire Fighting Training was held at the college on 23rd August, 2025. The students got Hands-on experience as the programme practically demonstrated defence tricks.
- Aiming at the awareness, movie screening of the Gujarati movie ‘Behadd’ was arranged by the college free of cost for the students on 3rd March, 2026. The story of the film focuses on a young man who hides his true identity to marry a girl and force a religious conversion.
- In association with BAOU and Gender Resource, Women and Child Development Department, One day workshop – Setu was held at the college on 27th February 2026 where students were made aware of rights of women. More than 180 students participated in the workshop.
- In association with Elixir Foundation and TrueHome Finance, a Helmet Distribution programme was held on 05th February, 2026. IPS Chirag Patel, DCP Traffic graced the event and guided the students towards safe Road-Travel Etiquettes. 200 helmets were distributed to the students on the occasion.
- Annual Prize Distribution ceremony was held on 15th March, 2026 where 198 students were felicitated for their academic, cultural, curricular and extra-curricular achievements and contribution.
- A Medical Check Up camp was organised in association with Lions Club on 1st January, 2026 at the college. The team of expert doctors checked the students and suggested treatments and procedure for the diagnosed issues.
